BIS Ice Dance Test Session Clarification

At a recent meeting of the BIS Ice Dance Technical Advisory Committee it was decided as an interim measure, skaters would be permitted to use Competitive Free Dance programs and Elements as per the current competition season at any test sessions providing the minimum program length and all elements from each level of the standard test system are used.

Level 1-6	1min 30 secs +/- 5 secs
Level 7-8	2min +/- 10 secs
Level 9-10	3min +/- 10 secs

Please note: the programs may be longer in duration but must not be shorter than the times specified above

Choreographic Character Step sequences will be accepted in place of the normal Step Sequence requirement for Levels 1-6 ONLY.

Choreographic Sliding movements will not be considered as a fall unless there is a loss of control during the movement.

This is an OPTION available until the introduction of the re-structured test system or, in accordance with any further announcements which may be published by the T.A.C.

Pattern Dance music will remain as ISU music ONLY for all Pattern Dance tests at this time.
